SUMMARY

Big Idea: Steady Sojourners think back, live ready, and show mercy Closing out the 1-chapter letter of Jude, these verses aim to encourage the readers to be very engaged in their discernment of the church environment around them. Scoffers have come in trying to deny the promises of God and they are leading people astray. Jude calls the reader to three primary actions: THINK, LIVE, SHOW. Jude connects the Scriptures of the Old Testament with the apostles, and calls Christians to live in such a way that both protects and promotes truth. Jude concludes with a powerful doxology exalting Christ in awe-filled worship.
