Series Overview: Ephesians 4:17-24; Colossians 3:1-17

To Live out the Gospel, Christians are commanded in the Bible to put off our old ways of living that lead to death and put on new ways of living that lead to life. The old ways correspond with our old self, and the new ways correspond to our new self, which has been created after the likeness of God in righteousness. These ways of living involve our whole being - how we Think (Head), what we Believe, Love and Desire (Heart), as well as how we Behave (Hands). Through the Gospel of Jesus, God has redeemed our whole being, and for His glory, His aim is to conform us to the image of His Son by transforming us from the inside out to walk in a manner worthy of the Gospel we have received. This series will challenge and grow us, as we aim to put off what may be considered 'respectable' sins, and put on their counterpart forms of Christlikeness, to better reflect and display that we have been brought from death to life.

Discussion Questions

What was the Big Idea? What was the Main Scripture Passage?
Read the passage(s) together and make initial observations: context, structure/flow, main point.

From Death (Put Off)

How does the Bible define this element of our Old Self?

(Head) Where do you see this show up in your thoughts?

(Heart) How does this influence what you desire, love, and hope for?

(Hands) What fruit does this bear in the way you live?

To Life (Put On)

How does the Bible define this element of our New Self in Christ?

(Head) How should this inform the way we think about God, ourselves, and those around us?

(Heart) What truths are we called to believe? How does this faith influence our affections, desires and hopes?

(Hands) What actions and behaviors accompany this element of our new life?



Closing: In light of this teaching, what is one specific way that you desire to show that you have been brought from Death to Life this week?
